A draft mailout - re Bulk Garbage Curbside Pickup Service was given to Councillors.

MOTION - Moved by Councillor Roberts, seconded by Councillor Byrne 20-076 that Council accept the proposal for Bulk Garbage Curbside Pickup Service.
- Motion carried. Votes in favor - 6 Councillors.

Mailouts will be sent to residents. The service will start Wednesday, July 29, 2020.

The service is not for Commercial use.

Council agreed the process will be reviewed in the fall.

The Town Manager presented some facts and figures regarding the town's regular curbside garbage collection.

The existing garbage trucks have now reached the end of their usefulness for this service. The cost of a new truck and repayment schedule, plus labour for the service would be more than the full service provided by Central NL Waste Management.

After discussion and consideration, Council agreed to request CNWM to provide the garbage collection service.
